Elm House is a beautiful four storey village home fully deserving of its grade II listing as a property of historic importance. Elm House dates back to the mid-18th century, probably 1730, and unusually for its location was built to three storeys high, although this is now four with further bedrooms created in the attic space, or five including the cellar. The kitchen, which has a range cooker and modern units, leads open plan into a breakfasting area and a pantry. The principal reception room, with its feature slate chimney breast, is in a super position at the back of the house to take full advantage of the attractive, private garden.
